**Rosh Hashanah:** evening of September 25th to evening of Sept. 27th

**Yom Kippur:** evening of October 4th to Oct. 5th

**Thanksgiving:** November 24th

**Christmas:** December 25th

Note: The Conservative movement of American Judaism adheres to a more traditional calendar, while the Reform movement celebrates slightly shorter holidays. We have included the Conservative dates for Jewish holidays above, since they represent the longest period of time during which a holiday may be celebrated.
